WAR IN ISRAEL

- Joshua 10 a confederacy comes against Gibeon and Joshua and Israel come to their aid.
- Revelation 16/Zechariah 14 a confederacy will come against Jerusalem and Christ and the saints will come to their aid.
- Joshua 11 a confederacy comes against Joshua and Israel

"For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle"

JABIN KING OF HAZOR

- Jabin from root meaning wise or understanding - means "whom God observes or understands"
- Represents the Beast System of Revelation – Catholic System which God has singled out for particular destruction

And the angel said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel? I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carrieth her, which hath the seven heads and ten horns" Revelation 17:7

"And here is the mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth" Revelation 17:9

 Joshua 11:1-3 Jabin gathers a confederacy together "And it came to pass, when Jabin king of Hazor had heard those things, that he sent to Jobab king of Madon, and to the king of Shimron, and to the king of Achshaph, and to the kings that were on the north of the mountains, and of the plains south of Chinneroth, and in the valley, and in the borders of Dor on the west, and to the Canaanite on the east and on the west, and to the Amorite, and the Hittite, and the Perizzite, and the Jebusite in the mountains, and to the Hivite under Hermon in the land of Mizpeh" Joshua 11:1-3

- 1. Joshua 11:1-3 Jabin gathers a confederacy together
- 2. Joshua 11:10 Jabin is the "head"

"And Joshua at that time turned back, and took Hazor, and smote the king thereof with the sword: for Hazor beforetime was the head of all those kingdoms" Joshua 11:10

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- 3. Joshua 11:4 they rode horses

"And they went out, they and all their hosts with them, much people, even as the sand that is upon the sea shore in multitude, with horses and chariots very many" Joshua 11:4

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- Joshua 11:5 they assemble to fight against Joshua and Israel

"And when all these kings were met together, they came and pitched together at the waters of Merom, to fight against Israel" Joshua 11:5

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"And they went out, they and all their hosts with them, much people, even as the sand that is upon the sea shore in multitude, with horses and chariots very many. And when all these kings were met together, they came and pitched together at the waters of Merom, to fight against Israel" Joshua 11:4-5

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"And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast. These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast" Revelation 17:12-13

- 8. Joshua 11:7 at God's appointed time

"So Joshua came, and all the people of war with him, against them by the waters of Merom suddenly; and they fell upon them" Joshua 11:7

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- Joshua 11:8 Misrephothmaim means "burnings of water"

"And the LORD delivered them into the hand of Israel, who smote them, and chased them unto great Zidon, and unto Misrephoth-maim, and unto the valley of Mizpeh eastward; and they smote them, until they left them none remaining" Joshua 11:8

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"And Joshua did unto them as the LORD bade him: he houghed their horses, and burnt their chariots with fire" Joshua 11:9

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"Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her." Revelation 18:8

- Joshua 11:11 only Hazor burned
- Joshua 11:12-13 remainder destroyed after but not burnt
- Thus they watched Hazor being burnt first?



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- Joshua 11:14 spoil of the cities taken by Israel

"And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance."

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- Joshua 11:14 spoil of the cities taken by Israel
- Seven years
- How long did conquering the land take?

- Caleb "Forty years old was I when Moses the servant of the LORD sent me from Kadesh-barnea to espy out the land" Joshua 14:7
- 38 years wandering
- "And now, behold, the LORD hath kept me alive, as he said, these forty and five years .. I am this day fourscore and five years old." Joshua 14:10
- 85-78(40+38)=7 years

KINGDOM ESTABLISHED

- Joshua 11:22-23
- Some remain as mortality will for 1,000 years.
- But bound for 1,000 years hence the land will be at rest.
- Joshua 12 33 kings overcome to establish the kingdom
- Type of Christ's victory 33 years of strong crying and tears
